

Instructions for Accessing and Administering ImPACT Baseline Tests

Go to HYPERLINK "<http://www.IndianaSportsConcussionNetwork.com>"
www.IndianaSportsConcussionNetwork.com

Click on “ImPACT baseline log-in” on the right side of the page

Under log-in click on “this link” to redirect to the log-in page

Click on “ImPACT Test Login” on the left side of the page

A new window will appear. Scroll down. Click on PayPal and create an account. Click “Review Order and Continue”

You will be re-directed to the ImPACT Test Online page. From the drop-down menu, choose the county where your school is located. Click “Launch Baseline Test”

A new window will be opened in the entire screen.

Enter the ISCN password: **WPZCY6QMNJ**

Click “English” or other appropriate first language.

Leave the default “English” units on the next screen; just click “Next.”

Read the ImPACT test process, click “Next.”

Choose the “Unsupervised” bubble, click “Next.”

CORRECT INFORMATION IS KEY!! Choose your school from the drop down menu of “School/Organization.” If the correct school is not listed, check that the correct county has been chosen and displayed in the “Clinic Name” box above. Enter the date of birth. Click “Next.”

Test taker enters Name. Choose Height and enter Weight (if unsure of exact, approximate as closely as possible). Click appropriate gender and handedness (related to sport).

Choose native country from drop-down list. Choose language; choose second language if applicable. Click “Next.”

Complete “Sport and Health History” and “Current Symptoms and Conditions.” Read

directions at top, focusing on “*currently experiencing*” symptoms. Click “Next” to begin test.

Remind test takers to read all instructions very carefully TWICE. If directions are not followed, the test will have to be retaken. Focus on own test, not others’ near them. Answer as quickly yet accurately as possible. Every mouse movement and time interval is tracked.

After the test, proctor should send an email to [HYPERLINK](#) "mailto:concussion@methodistsports.com" concussion@methodistsports.com to let us know how many tests were just created so that the physicians may look at those baselines to see if any athletes need to retake the test.
